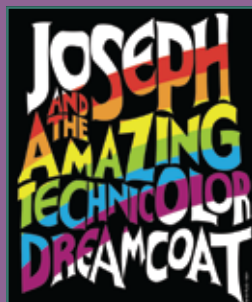

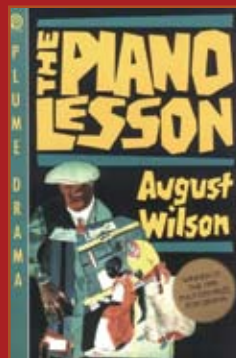

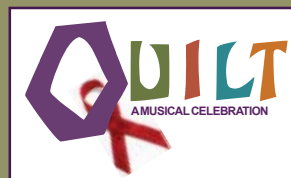
of the artist in any society, this important play was the winner of the New York Drama Critics Circle award for Best Foreign Play.

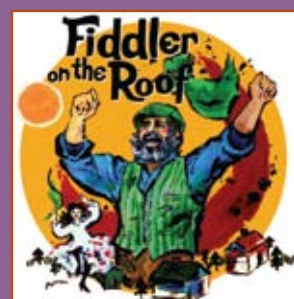
