**AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:** Prepare and memorize 16-32 measures of a show tune as a parody (over the top) that best shows off your vocal qualities and range. Feel free to imitate and spoof the original Broadway performer of your song. Be sure to bring piano/vocal sheet music for the accompanist. Do not expect the pianist to transpose music. Pianist is provided.

**WHERE:** Auditions will be held at the Arts United Center at 303 East Main Street. Enter from the rear of the building, using the glass doors to the Green Room. Please arrive 15 minutes early to check in. If you didn't email your audition form and photo to Eunice in advance, bring it with you to give to the stage manager upon arrival.

**CAST OF CHARACTERS:** We encourage all ethnicities to audition. **Minimum age 18 years old.**

We need strong singer, actors who can move well. The show specifically features parodies of the character ANNIE, and Broadway Stars Carol Channing, Chita Rivera, Rita Moreno, Mandy Patinkin, and Liza and more...
