

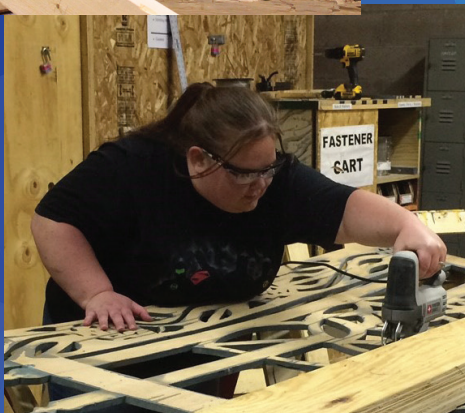
The Fort Wayne Civic Theatre is a people-powered organization and we rely on enthusiastic volunteers looking to work on stage, backstage, and on build crews!

PRODUCTION

DRESSERS

- Assists actors with costumes before, during, and after shows, or assists with quick changes when needed.

PROPS CREW

- Responsible for location and organization of props.

FLOOR CREW

- Works backstage to prep the stage for each scene change. Ensures that all set pieces are in their proper location at the beginning, during, and end of each performance.

FLY CREW

- Brings any flying elements for the show in and out as cued by the Stage Manager.

SPOTLIGHT OPERATOR

- Operates spotlights during shows as cued by the Stage Manager.

LIGHTING TEAM

- Helps Lighting Designer to hang and focus lights according to the light plot.

OPPORTUNITIES

PRE-PRODUCTION

BUILD AND PAINT CREW

- Work in the Scene Shop and on stage to construct and paint the sets and scenic pieces for each play or musical.

COSTUME CREW

- Assists in making or gathering all of the costumes for a play or musical.
- Opportunities exist for hand sewers, machine sewers and crafters.

STAGE MANAGEMENT

STAGE MANAGER

- Oversees all activities of the cast and crew during rehearsals and performances.
- Arrives early, runs rehearsals, calls shows, and works closely with designers involved with the production.
- Maintains the director's interpretation during performances.

ASSISTANT STAGE MANAGER

- Responsible for keeping track of cast, sets, props, and other details during rehearsals and performances.
- Attends all rehearsals and assists the Stage Manager in any assignments given.

ACTORS SINGERS DANCERS

- No experience required to audition.
- 6-10 week commitment from auditions through close of show.
- Rehearsals - Evening hours Monday - Friday, some weekend hours may be added.
