Please prepare to sing approximately one verse or one chorus of a Jimmy Buffett song or a Juke Box song. If you are called to attend the call back auditions, you will be asked to dance and we will provide sides and music cuts for you to sing.

<u>WHERE:</u> Auditions will be held at Fort Wayne Civic Theatre at Foster Park Plaza (1940 Bluffton Rd., 46809). Please arrive 15 minutes early to check in. If you didn't email your audition form and photo to Gavin in advance, bring it with you to give to the stage manager upon arrival.

<u>CHARACTERS:</u> Estimated Cast of 17-20. We encourage actors of all ethnicities to audition. We are committed to casting a group of actors that accurately reflects our community. Actors of all sizes, shapes, race, gender, and ability will be considered.

Tully: Male (age 27-39, vocal range B2-C5) Smooth-talking, self-deprecating playboy. He's completely content with the life he's chosen as the singer/bartender at a tropical resort, until he meets Rachel, a vacationer who upends his heart. Guitar skills are useful.

Rachel: Female (age 27-33, vocal range A3-F#5) Fully committed to her job and helping the world. Willing to put in as many hours of hard work as it takes and expects everyone else to do that same. Suspicious of fools and operators, Rachel is not easily distracted from her life plan.

Tammy: Female (age 30-39, vocal range B3-F5) Loyal friend to Rachel. Sees the best in people and has a zest for life that is often squelched by her fiancé, Chad.

Brick: Male (age 30-39, vocal range A2-C5) The Island bartender. Has a big heart and is a good friend to Tully. Not the brightest bulb, but sensitive and thoughtful.

Marley: Female (age 40-49, vocal range G#3-G#5) No-nonsense and assertive with an island accent. She runs the resort and keeps everyone in check, but clearly cares about her employees, her customers, and J.D., an older island denizen. Great singer.

J.D.: Male (age 60-79, vocal range G2-D4) A funny, endearing older man who always has a parrot on his shoulder. He's losing his vision and his hearing but won't acknowledge it. A good-natured drunkard, he's always writing his memoirs on bar napkins and, as it turns out, he's lived a full life.

Jamal: Comedic, nervous. Jamal is the busboy and Marley's right-hand man at Margaritaville.

Ensemble: Angela, Alan, Ginger, Tina, Tony Jaffe, Alix Jaffe, Ted, Chadd, Goons, Vacation Guests etc.
